AGREEMENT

This Agreement made thisda	ay of	, 2006, by and between David
O. Hill. Ph.D., P.A., located at 7637	Canterbury, Prairie V	illage, Kansas, hereinafter referred to
as "Dr. Hill," and the City of Overla	nd Park, Kansas, a mu	inicipal corporation, hereinafter
referred to as "City," the City of Ove	erland Park being a Ci	ty in the first class, located at 8500
Santa Fe, Overland Park, Kansas 662	212.	

The parties to this Agreement, in consideration of the mutual covenants and stipulations set out herein, agree as follows:

- **1. Psychological Services.** Dr. Hill shall provide the following psychological services at those times indicated herein and on an as needed basis to the Police Department:
 - a. Pre-employment psychological examinations with written reports for police officers, reserve officers and communications officer candidates, as well as any other individual referred for such examinations by the Police Department. All pre-employment psychological examinations shall be conducted post-job offer and shall include written reports that satisfy the City's requirements pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act.
 - b. Re-testing of candidates for pre-employment psychological examinations with written reports. Dr. Hill and other departmental psychological consultants will consult with the Department regarding appropriate assignment for pre-employment and re-testing of applicants.
 - c. Critical incident debriefings for officers who have been involved in critical incidents involving high stress, to include shooting incidents and other incidents as determined by the Chief of Police.
 - d. Stress management counseling for undercover officers and others as directed by the Chief of Police.
 - e. Professional consultation with Police Department staff members to promote executive development, education and training and other matters related to the area of mental health as directed by the Chief of Police.
 - f. At the request of the Police Department, Dr. Hill may provide services in addition to those described herein. Dr. Hill will be compensated at the same hourly rate for those additional services.
- **2. City's reliance on Dr. Hill's professional expertise.** The parties agree that the City is relying on Dr. Hill's professional expertise in the area of psychological services to make important decisions relating to the operation of the Police Department.

3. Schedule and time of performance.

- A. Dr. Hill agrees to provide the professional services set forth in Paragraph 1 above for a minimum of two (2) days each week, five (5) hours per day for a period of forty-six (46) weeks. The days of the week and the weeks of the year Dr. Hill will devote to providing psychological services to the City shall be agreed to by the parties. Should Dr. Hill be unavailable to provide the required professional services during the two five (5) hour days each week, the compensation to be paid Dr. Hill will be reduced accordingly.
- B. In addition to being available for the minimum period of ten (10) hours each week, Dr. Hill agrees to provide the aforementioned psychological services on an as needed basis, provided Dr. Hill agrees that unless an emergency exists he will schedule all agreed upon services during the ten (10) hours he is scheduled to work with the department.
- C. Dr. Hill agrees to accommodate the psychological testing of the large number of police officer candidates during the Police Departments scheduled hiring periods. During these hiring periods Dr. Hill agrees to be available to conduct psychological examinations for a minimum of fifteen (15) hours per week and further agrees to evaluate a minimum of seven (7) candidates per each fifteen (15) hour period. The parties agree that the number of hours Dr. Hill devotes to providing psychological testing during the Police Department hiring periods will count toward satisfying Dr. Hill's weekly minimum of ten (10) hours. For example, if Dr Hill provides fifteen (15) hours of service providing officer candidate psychologicals, this will satisfy Dr. Hill's responsibility to provide a minimum of ten (10) hours per week for the subsequent one and one-half (1½) weeks.
- **4. Services to be requested as needed by the Police Department.** The parties agree and understand that all services rendered by Dr. Hill pursuant to this Agreement shall be on an as needed basis and solely at the request of the Police Department.
- 5. Consideration. In consideration of the psychological services set forth in Paragraph (1) above, the Police Department shall pay Dr. Hill at the rate of one hundred twenty and 00/100 dollars (\$120.00) per hour of service. Portions of an hour shall be prorated to the nearest fifteen (15) minutes. Should Dr. Hill fulfill the requirements of this Agreement to provide psychological services a minimum of ten (10) hours per week for forty-six (46) weeks the consideration for services rendered during this period would total fifty five thousand two hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$55,200.00). The parties agree that Dr. Hill shall only receive payment for those hours or portions of hours actually worked. Dr. Hill shall provide a detailed billing statement for all services rendered to the City.

- **6. Services requested by Police Department.** Dr. Hill agrees and understands that the professional services rendered pursuant to this Agreement are requested by the Overland Park Police Department and all counseling, findings, and opinions whether written or otherwise, shall be communicated to the Overland Park Police Department as the Department requests it, subject to the confidentiality limitations of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- **7. Term of Agreement.** The term of this Agreement shall be one (1) year from the date of execution of this document.
- **8. Right of termination.** Either party has a right to terminate this Agreement with or without cause by giving thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party. The City may terminate this Agreement at any time should Dr. Hill fail to fulfill the obligations set forth in this Agreement.
- **9. Agreement not exclusive.** This Agreement is not an exclusive agreement for services between the parties. The Police Department has an absolute right to use or seek psychological services from anyone at any time. In addition, the Police Department has an absolute right to have any work performed by Dr. Hill reviewed by anyone it chooses.
- 10. Insurance. Dr. Hill shall secure and maintain throughout the duration of this Agreement, insurance of such types and in at least such amounts as set forth herein. Professional liability insurance must be maintained for a period of no less than two years after the term of this Agreement. Dr. Hill shall provide certificates of insurance and renewals thereof to the City. The City shall be notified by receipt of written notice from the insurer at least thirty (30) days prior to material modification or cancellation of any policy listed on the Certificate. All insurance coverages and forms are subject to the approval of the City and can be rejected if deemed unacceptable.

- 11. Non-discrimination. Dr. Hill shall observe the provisions of the Kansas Act against Discrimination to include the specific requirements set forth in Attachment A attached hereto, and all federal laws concerning discrimination, and shall not discriminate against any person in the performance of work under this Agreement because of race, religion, sex, physical disability, national origin or ancestry. If Dr. Hill violates the provisions of the Kansas Act against Discrimination, federal laws or the provisions of this paragraph, he shall be deemed to have breached the conditions of this Agreement and as a result the City may cancel, terminate, or suspend the Agreement, in whole or in part.
- **12. Non-Assignment.** Dr. Hill agrees not to assign or transfer the responsibilities of this Agreement without the permission of the Police Department.
- **13. Performance of services by Dr. Hill.** Dr. Hill agrees that he shall perform the professional services personally and that he shall not utilize other professionals or staff to perform services unless agreed to in writing by the Police Department.
- **14. Hold harmless.** Dr. Hill agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Overland Park Police Department, the City of Overland Park and its agents and/or employees from any and all claims, settlements and judgments for personal injury, property damage, death or any other cause of action arising out of the services rendered pursuant to this Agreement. Neither acceptance of the completed work nor payment therefore shall be a release from Dr. Hill's obligation under this paragraph.
- **15. Independent contractor.** In no event, while performing the obligations under this Agreement, shall Dr. Hill be authorized to act as an employee of the City, but shall for all purposes be deemed an independent contractor in his relation to the City.
- **16. Entire Agreement.** This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties, and no statements, promises, or inducements made by either party or agent of either party that are not contained herein shall be valid or binding.

ATTACHMENT A

Dr. Hill agrees that:

- 1. He shall observe the provisions of the Kansas Act Against Discrimination (K.S.A. 44-1001 et seq.) and shall not discriminate against any person in the performance of work under the present contract because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, ancestry or age;
- 2. In all solicitations or advertisements for employees, he shall include the phrase, "equal opportunity employer," or a similar phrase to be approved by the Kansas Human Rights Commission (Commission);

If he fails to comply with the manner in which he reports to the Commission in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 44-1031 and amendments thereto, he shall be deemed to have breached the present contract and it may be canceled, terminated or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting agency;
- 4. If he is found guilty of a violation of the Kansas Act Against Discrimination under a decision or order of the commission which has become final, he shall be deemed to have breached the present contract and it may be canceled, terminated or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting agency; and
- 5. He shall include the provisions of paragraphs (1) through (4) above in every subcontract or purchase order so that such provisions will be binding upon such subcontractor or vendor.
- 6. He further agrees that he shall abide by the Kansas Age Discrimination In Employment Act (K.S.A. 44-1111 et seq.) and the applicable provision of the Americans With Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. 1201 et seq.) as well as all other federal, state and local laws, ordinances and regulations applicable to this project and to furnish any certification required by any federal, state or local laws, ordinances and regulations applicable to this project and to furnish any certification required by any federal, state or local governmental agency in connection therewith.
