**Re:** Street Light Maintenance Agreement – Leased Lighting Purchase

**Policy Issue:** City policy requires Governing Body approval of Agreements exceeding \$50,000 in value.

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends the agreement with Black & McDonald be approved to provide street light maintenance for a fee not to exceed \$110,000.00.

**Background:** The City has entered into an agreement with KCP&L to purchase street lights that are currently being leased. The purchase and subsequent transfer of ownership of the lights to the City is scheduled to occur on July 1, 2013. The agreement with Black and McDonald provides for the continuation of maintenance and repair to these lights. Public Works is seeking to contractually provide for this work due to the need for specialized labor skills in working with direct connect power feeds from individual street lights to KCP&L's high voltage power grid.

**Budget Impact:** None, funds are available within the Traffic Maintenance operating budget.
