WHEREAS, the Overland Park City Council is interested in creating an atmosphere in which international economic development and trade can be developed, implemented and strengthened; and


WHEREAS, the Overland Park City Council is interested in fostering environments through which municipal partnerships can creatively learn, work and solve problems together; and



WHEREAS, the Overland Park City Council is committed to creating, in addition to economic and business opportunities, cultural and educational experiences for the citizens of Overland Park through long term municipal partnerships.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, that,

A Sister City Committee be established by the Governing Body of Overland Park to assist and advise on matters relating to the City's implementation and direction of Sister City programs. The Mayor shall serve as Chair of the committee and appoint a representative of the City Council to serve. The committee shall consist of 12 additional members appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council: one member appointed by each member of the Finance, Administration and Economic Development Committee to serve three year terms; one representative from each of three local school districts to serve two year terms; one representative from Johnson County Community College to serve a two year term; one representative from the Overland Park Economic Development Council to serve a two year term; one representative from the Overland Park Chamber of Commerce to serve a two year term; and one representative from the Overland Park Convention and Visitors Bureau to serve a two year term.
