FY2022 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)

The City of Overland Park's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Citizens' Advisory Committee will begin their review and allocation process for the estimated \$700,000 in CDBG funds the city anticipates to receive in calendar year 2022. Pending Congressional actions of the administration's FY2022 budget proposal, the amount may change significantly. The funds are from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and must be targeted to benefit low and moderate income areas and residents of the city.

Public hearings provide an opportunity for citizens to learn about the project proposals requesting CDBG funding and to provide feedback on ways to better serve the targeted population with the community.
