

Community Notification

The City of Overland Park, Kansas, Planning & Development Services Department, in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of its intent to revise the flood hazard information, generally located near the intersection of W. 101st Street and Connell Drive. The flood hazard revisions are being proposed as part of Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) Case No. 21-07-0777R for a proposed project along Indian Creek Tributary 5. The City of Overland Park is proposing to construct channel widening and deepening improvements as part of improving stormwater capacity within the project limits.

Once the project has been completed, a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) request should be submitted that will, in part, revise the following flood hazards along Indian Creek Tributary 5.

1. The floodway will be revised from a point approximately 280 feet downstream of Connell Drive to a point approximately 980 feet upstream of Connell Drive.
2. Base Flood Elevations will decrease along Indian Creek Tributary 5.
3. The Special Flood Hazard Area will decrease along Indian Creek Tributary 5.
