

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT
TO THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK'S

Notice is hereby given to all interested agencies, groups and residents of Overland Park of a proposed Substantial Amendment to the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) FFY2020-2024 Consolidated Plan. The Overland Park Planning and Development Services Department is proposing an amendment to identify five public infrastructure projects to be funded by \$300,000 of available CDBG funds as part of the Neighborhood Improvement Program. The proposed projects are as follows:

1. Brown Park	4751 Hadley	\$40,000
2. Hickory Hills Park	8420 West 54 th Terrace	\$18,000
3. Kessler Park	7827 Kessler	\$98,000
4. Robinson Park	7899 West 60 th Street	\$69,000
5. OP Elementary Access Tunnel	Santa Fe and Robinson	\$75,000

This proposed amendment would constitute a substantial amendment to FFY2020-2024 Consolidated Plan. The City's Citizen Participation Plan calls for a public comment period from October 26, 2021 through 5:00 p.m. on December 06, 2021, before making this amendment.

The Governing Body of Overland Park will conduct a public hearing on the matter at its regularly scheduled meeting to be held at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, December 06, 2021 in Council Chambers, City Hall, 8500 Santa Fe Drive, Overland Park, KS 66212.

To reduce the spread of COVID19, social distancing guidelines will be followed at the meeting. There will be a limited seating in the Council Chambers for members of the public. The public is encouraged to view the live stream at opkansas.civicweb.net and selecting "Watch Live" or by viewing or listening to the meeting via an online virtual meeting tool.

Members of the public may participate in legally required public hearings or when invited by the Mayor to provide comments on an agenda item by 1) submitting written comments in advance of the meeting at the links provided on the agenda where public comments will be accepted or 2) providing comments via the on-line virtual meeting tool.

Persons who wish to appear before the Governing Body to provide in-person comments will be asked to abide by social distancing guidelines and, depending on the number of persons in attendance, may be asked to wait outside the Council Chamber until the item is being considered by the Governing Body.
