

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT ON THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK'S
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

Notice is hereby given to all interested agencies, groups and residents of Overland Park that the City of Overland Park's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) proposed Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2022 Annual Action Plan is available for review and comment.

The FFY 2022 Annual Action Plan is the third year plan of the previously submitted 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan. The 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan is a Community Development Plan that outlines how the City plans to spend federal CDBG received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Priorities of the Consolidated Plan designate the provision of public facility and infrastructure improvements, housing rehabilitation, economic development, and public services to meet the needs of low and moderate-income residents.

The city of Overland Park anticipates receiving approximately \$750,000 in CDBG funds in 2022. Allocations listed below are not final; once the City receives the final FFY 2022 allocation, totals may adjust.

The CDBG Advisory Committee recommends the following use of funds to the City Council:

The city of Overland Park determined that if the 2022 CDBG allocation is less than the anticipated \$750,000, the grant funding will be calculated as follows:

- 1) All allocations will be reduced on a pro-rata basis for the amount below \$750,000; and
- 2) Public Service projects will not exceed 15% of the total allocation.

The city of Overland Park determined that if the 2022 CDBG allocation exceeds the anticipated \$750,000, the grant funding will be calculated as follows:

- 1) Additional funds will be allocated to Johnson County Park and Recreation District and YMCA of Greater Kansas City, up to \$15,000 each; and
- 2) Awards for projects in the Housing and Economic Development categories will remain at the current funding levels; and
- 3) Administration allocation will remain at \$100,000; and
- 4) Any additional funds will go to the Sudden Opportunity Program.

A copy of the Action Plan will be available for review or comment beginning on November 23, 2021 through December 31, 2021. The public is welcome to review the Action Plan at any of the locations listed below:

The Governing Body of Overland Park will conduct a public hearing on the matter at its regularly scheduled meeting to be held at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, January 24, 2022 in Council Chambers, City Hall, 8500 Santa Fe Drive, Overland Park, KS 66212. The public is welcome to attend the meeting and to comment regarding the 2022 Annual Action Plan.

Members of the public may participate in legally required public hearings or when invited by the Mayor to provide comments on an agenda item by 1) submitting written comments in advance of the meeting at the links provided on the agenda where public comments will be accepted or 2) providing in-person comments.
