

## **PUBLICATION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. TC-1260,FFFF**

### **SUMMARY**

On May 16, 2022, the City of Overland Park, Kansas, passed Ordinance No. TC-1260,FFFF, amending Overland Park Municipal Code Title 12 and provisions therein pertaining to the regulation of traffic, parade permits, and towing in the City. The ordinance includes numerous updates to traffic code sections based on corresponding changes that have been made to state statutes and recent court rulings (*Chapters 12.04 and 12.08*); updates requirements for the City to tow vehicles and sell impounded vehicles (*Chapter 12.20*); imposes maximum storage and tow fees for tows requested by third parties (*Chapter 12.21*); and modifies criteria for late parade permit applications (*Section 12.16.030*). The ordinance also adds code provisions related to passing utility and telecommunications vehicles (*Section 12.04.044.3*) and displaying license plates (*Section 12.04.195.2*), and repeals code provisions prohibiting television receivers on vehicles (*Section 12.04.176.2*) and relating to weight requirements for rubber tired earth scrapers (*Section 12.04.196.1.5*). This ordinance is subject to petition pursuant to state law.
