

ORDINANCE NO. POC-3364

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS; CONCERNING INTOXICATING LIQUOR IN PUBLIC PLACES; AMENDING AND REPEALING EXISTING OVERLAND PARK MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.48.160.N AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

Section 1. Subsection N of Overland Park Municipal Code Section 11.48.160 is hereby amended to read as follows:

N. Intoxicating liquor and beer may be sold, served, dispensed and consumed within the boundaries of the Thompson Park in accordance with and to the extent allowed by the written standards approved by the Director, Parks Services.

Section 2. Existing subsection N of Overland Park Municipal Code Section 11.48.160 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The remaining provisions and subsections of Overland Park Municipal Code Section 11.48.160 not amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in an official City newspaper.
