

RESOLUTION NO. 4831

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO APPROPRIATE PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF STORMWATER INFRASTRUCTURE, 2022 MAJOR STORM SEWER REPAIR, IN THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS (PROJECT NO. MS-1739).

WHEREAS, the City of Overland Park, Kansas, has heretofore authorized and directed certain improvements in the City as more fully described below (the “Improvements”); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate private property for the construction of the Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

Section 1. It is hereby declared necessary to acquire private property for the use of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, for the following described improvements:

The City’s 2022 Major Storm Sewer Repair project (MS-1739) consists of the replacement of aging and deteriorating storm sewer infrastructure at five site locations. The project includes the replacement of approximately 2,000 linear feet of corrugated metal pipes and associated storm sewer structures, six wing walls, impacted curb and gutter, sidewalk, driveways, street, fences, property restoration, utility relocation, and other items incidental to the construction and necessary appurtenances thereto (the “Improvements”).

The Improvements are generally located at or near the following areas: 87th Terrace between Bond Street and Nieman Road, 9229 Foster Street, 99th Street and Rosewood, 147th Terrace and Hadley Street (East of Antioch Road) and 170th Street between Antioch Road and Grandview Street all in the City of Overland park, Kansas.

Section 2. It is hereby authorized and directed that a survey and description of the lands or interests therein to be condemned be made by a licensed land surveyor or a professional engineer who is competent to conduct a land survey and be filed with the City Clerk of the City of Overland Park, Kansas.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in an official City newspaper.
