RESOLUTION NO. 4877

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO APPROPRIATE PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF STORMWATER INFRASTRUCTURE AS PART OF THE STORM DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (KNOX DRIVE TO 99TH TERRACE), IN THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS (PROJECT NO. SD-1740).

WHEREAS, the City of Overland Park, Kansas, has heretofore authorized and directed certain improvements in the City as more fully described below (the "Improvements"); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate private property for the construction of the Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> It is hereby declared necessary to acquire private property for the use of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, for the following described improvements:

The City's Storm Drainage Improvements project (Knox Drive to 99th Terrace) (Project No. SD-1740) consisting of the replacement of aging, deteriorating and undersized concrete ditch liner located from Knox Drive to 99th Terrace, between Connell Drive and Knox Drive; the replacement of two undersized box culverts, one at Knox Drive and another one at 99th Terrace; and the replacement of storm sewer pipes and inlet systems that drain into the ditch liner, including property restoration, utility relocation, and other items incidental to the construction and necessary appurtenances thereto (the "Improvements").

<u>Section 2.</u> It is hereby authorized and directed that a survey and description of the lands or interests therein to be condemned be made by a licensed land surveyor or a professional engineer who is competent to conduct a land survey and be filed with the City Clerk of the City of Overland Park, Kansas.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in an official City newspaper.
