

NOTICE OF SPECIAL QUESTION MAIL BALLOT ELECTION

Notice is given to the qualified electors of the City of Overland Park, Kansas (“City”) that an election has been called and will be held on June 22, 2023, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City the following proposition:

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall the City of Overland Park, Kansas (the "City"), be authorized to levy a three-eighth of one percent (0.375%) Special Purpose City Retailers’ Sales Tax within the City of Overland Park, Kansas (also known as “OP Moves”), and to use the revenue from the tax, in whole or in part with any other funds, to fund an infrastructure improvement program consisting of repairing, rebuilding, rehabilitating, upgrading, constructing and improving City streets and related infrastructure, and to fund a traffic management program, including but not limited to, repairing, upgrading and replacing traffic signalization; such tax to take effect on April 1, 2024, the day following expiration of the existing one-eighth of one percent (0.125%) Special Purpose City Retailers’ Sales Tax; such tax to end March 31, 2034; and such tax to be in addition to the ongoing one percent (1.0%) City Retailers’ Sales Tax currently levied?

The election will be conducted in accordance with the Mail Ballot Election Act, K.S.A. 25-431 *et seq.* (“Act”). The Act provides that the Election Commissioner of Johnson County, Kansas, shall conduct the election by mailing an official ballot to each elector entitled to vote in the election not sooner than the 20th day before the date of the election and not later than the 10th day before the election. Ballots will be mailed by first-class mail, addressed to the address of each elector appearing in the registration records and placed in an envelope which is prominently marked “Do Not Forward.” Instructions on how to mark the ballot to vote either for or against the proposition submitted thereon will accompany the ballots, together with a stamped, addressed return identification envelope in which the marked ballot must be placed.
