Notice is hereby given to all interested agencies, groups, and residents of Overland Park that the city's Citizen Participation Plan is available for review and comment. The Overland Park Planning and Development Services Department requests that the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park consider adopting an updated Citizen Participation Plan.

As part of the city's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, the Citizen Participation Plan provides policies and procedures for citizen participation in the development and evaluation of program plans and performance reports.

The city's current Citizen Participation Plan calls for a 15-day public comment period for proposed amendments to the adopted Citizen Participation Plan. For this request, the public comment period begins on Wednesday, May 24, 2023, and ends on Friday, June 9, 2023.

The Governing Body of Overland Park will conduct a public hearing on the matter at its regularly scheduled meeting to be held at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, July 10, 2023, in Council Chambers, City Hall, 8500 Santa Fe Drive, Overland Park, KS 66212.

There will be limited seating in the Council Chambers for members of the public. The public is encouraged to view the live stream at opkansas.civicweb.net and select "Watch Live".

Members of the public may participate in legally required public hearings when invited by the Mayor to provide comments on an agenda item. The city will also receive written comments in advance of the meeting at the links provided on the agenda where public comments will be accepted.
