At that time all sealed bids will be transferred to the **City Council Chambers**, City Hall, where they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Any bid received after the designated closing time will be returned unopened.

All bids shall be submitted in sealed envelopes addressed to the City Clerk of Overland Park, Kansas, and marked "**BID FOR:** <u>ON DEMAND CONCRETE REPAIR SERVICES</u>." No oral, facsimile or telephonic bids or alterations will be considered. Bids shall be made upon the form provided in ink or typewritten. Bids cannot be altered or changed after they have been received by the City and opened.

The quantities stated on the Bid form are estimates only. The City will request these services on an "as needed" basis. The unit price bid shall be in full force and effect through December 31, 2024. It is understood that alternate source contracts may be awarded and the City can utilize alternate sources based on availability, delivery time, and/or travel distance.

Bidders shall be aware that all materials received will be tested randomly by a certified lab to ensure adherence to the specifications.

The City reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids and to waive any technicalities or irregularities therein. Bids may be modified or withdrawn by written request of the bidder received in the office of the City Clerk, prior to the time and date for bid opening; provided, however, that no bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (30) days from the date set for the opening thereof. ALL BIDDERS AGREE THAT REJECTION SHALL CREATE NO LIABILITY ON THE PART OF THE CITY BECAUSE OF SUCH REJECTION. IT IS UNDERSTOOD BY ALL BIDDERS THAT AN UNSUCCESSFUL BIDDER HAS NO CAUSE OF ACTION AGAINST THE CITY FOR BID PREPARATION COSTS. THE FILING OF ANY BID IN RESPONSE TO THIS INVITATION SHALL CONSTITUTE AN AGREEMENT OF THE BIDDER TO THESE CONDITIONS.
