

ORDINANCE NO. MTI-3453

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT OF A MAIN TRAFFICWAY – QUIVIRA ROAD FROM 179TH STREET TO 187TH STREET IN THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS (PROJECT NO. TH-1147).

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-687 *et seq.* authorizes the Governing Body to improve or re-improve main trafficways; and

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of January, 1977, Quivira Road was designated a main trafficway by Ordinance No. MT-917; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Governing Body of Overland Park, Kansas, to improve Quivira Road from 179th Street to 187th Street as hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, all legal proceedings and requirements have been complied with for the public improvement of the main trafficway;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the following main trafficway be improved or reimproved as provided by K.S.A. 12-687 *et seq.*:

The construction and reconstruction of Quivira Road from 179th Street to 187th Street, consisting of two new bridges, new concrete pavement, shoulders, curb and gutter, storm sewers, sidewalk, multi-use trail, street lighting, and a roundabout, including property restoration, utility relocation, and other items incidental to the construction and necessary appurtenances thereto (the "Improvement").

Section 2. The estimated and probable cost of the Improvement is:

Twenty Two Million, Six Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$22,615,000.00).

Section 3. The Improvement shall be financed from revenue sources authorized by K.S.A. 12-689, including but not limited to the issuance of general obligation bonds.

Section 4. The City expects to incur expenses in connection with the Improvement prior to the issuance of the general obligation bonds and temporary notes which will be used to finance the Improvement. The City reasonably expects to reimburse a portion of the expenditures in connection with the Improvement from the proceeds of the general obligation debt. This declaration is a declaration of official intent of the City under Treasury Regulations. The maximum principal amount of debt expected to be issued is Eight Million Dollars (\$8,000,000.00).

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force as of the date of its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
