JOB SUMMARY STATEMENT:

Observes and protects the patrons of the City's public swimming pools. Enforces pool rules of safety, guards swimmers and rescues swimmers in danger of drowning. Attends mandatory training classes.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Enforces pool rules of safety. Guards and rescues swimmers in the danger of drowning.
2. Attends mandatory training to review all procedures for lifeguard duties. Performs swimming, diving and rescue maneuvers.
3. Attends certified lifeguard training and obtains CPR certificate. Renews annually.
4. Attends certified first aid training and obtains certificate. Renews annually.
5. The employee must work the days and hours necessary to perform all assigned responsibilities and tasks. Must be available (especially during regular business hours or shifts) to communicate with subordinates, supervisors, customers, vendors and any other persons or organization with whom interaction is required to accomplish work and employer goals.
6. The employee must be punctual and timely in meeting all requirements of performance, including, but not limited to, attendance standards and work deadlines; beginning and ending assignments on time; and scheduled work breaks, where applicable.
